JOB TITLE: Residency & Artist Projects Program Assistant

JOB STATUS: Part-time, Non-Exempt (10-15 hours a week, January-June, August-December)

REPORTS TO: Program Manager, Artist Residencies

PAY RANGE: \$20.00 - \$25.00/Hour

Overview

Work closely with the Program Manager to welcome and support artists, writers, dancers, and multi-disciplinary residents as part of the Artist Residency Program.

Essential Functions

Program Administration

- Check-in weekly with Program Manager to go over needs for the week and strategize for future programming.
- Support administration of calendar, invoicing, and preparing keys and welcome packets for residents each week.
- Support coordination of weekly coffee meet-ups and gatherings with residency cohorts and help cultivate community among the residents
- Help maintain and check inventory for cabins and resident pantry/tool library
- Help drive residents (using Centrum Vans) and provide transportation support for those without cars
- Support Program Manager in co-creating and coordinating details for site-specific artist projects and experimental exhibition planning.
- Support Program Manager with the submission review process.
- Provide on-call support to residents when Program Manager is not available.
- Provide more intensive support during October for the Emerging Artist Residency Program
- Troubleshoot any issues that arise in relationship to the program

Other Duties

- Some weekends and evening hours required.
- Overall support of events at Centrum.
- Other duties as assigned and developed in collaboration with the Program Manager

Qualifications

- Experience working with creative professionals or first-hand knowledge of residency/retreat programs

- Experience in hospitality, education, or an industry requiring a high degree of social interaction and support.
- Previous experience working in an arts organization highly desirable
- Access to transportation as needed and a good driving record, valid driver's license and insurance
- Ability to work on-site at least once a week. Some remote work is also possible.

Centrum Benefits

Employees who have established an employment relationship with Centrum but work less than twenty (20) hours per week are considered Casual employees. Casual employees are not eligible for Centrum benefit programs with the exception of the Employee Assistance Program and the Centrum Retirement Plan based on plan eligibility requirements. They will accrue sick time based on Washington state's Paid Sick Leave law (RCW 49.46.210). Casual employees are also eligible for participation in Centrum workshops with waived tuition, depending on the available space in the workshop.
